I. POLICY

- A. The purpose of this policy is to identify the responsible person required to supervise children younger than eleven in the library.
- B. Children between seven and ten years old may not be left in the library unattended; a parent, guardian, caregiver, teachers or non-staff member program facilitators must remain in the library while the child(ren) are in the building.
- C. Children six years old or younger must remain physically with a parent, guardian, caregiver, teachers or non-staff member program facilitators at all times while in the library.

- III. RESPONSIBILITY: The library director shall establish necessary procedures to comply with this policy.
