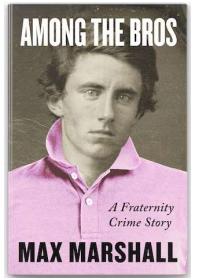

Writers Group

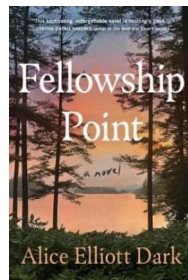
